Regulation

- 1. Title.

Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the School for Handicapped Children (Public Donations) Fund Regulations.

Interpretation.

- 2. In these regulations-
 - "Director" means the Director of Education;
 - "Fund" means the School for Handicapped Children (Public Donations) Fund;
 - "School" means the School for Handicapped Children.

Administration.

3. The Director shall be the controlling officer and shall administer and keep the accounts of the fund.

Composition.

- 4. The Fund shall consist of-
 - (a) all donations, whether testamentary or otherwise, received for the benefit of the School; and
 - (b) such other moneys, if any, as may accrue thereto by virtue of the provisions of section 20 of the Ordinance.

Use of Fund.

5. The Fund shall be used for such purposes for the benefit of the School as the Director may deem appropriate.

Provided that, without prejudice to the provisions of section 19(2) (b) of the Ordinance, any donation received for a specific purpose shall be applied for such purpose unless it is not reasonably practical, in the opinion of the Director, so to do.
