AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act (Chapter 131).

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Short title and amendment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1985.

Replacement Of Fifth Schedule

Public Health (Amendment) Act, 1985.

2. The Public Health Act is amended by repealing the Fifth Schedule, and substituting therefor the following new Schedule:

" FIFTH SCHEDULE.

Sections 116 and 119.

The salt water rate shall be –

- (i) in respect of shops, offices, stores, cafes, bars and other like premises at the rate of 2 pence in the pound;
- (ii) in respect of tenement buildings, flats and other dwellinghouses at the rate of 2 pence in the pound."
