## **SOCIAL SECURITY (EMPLOYMENT INJURIES INSURANCE) ACT**

### **MEDICAL CERTIFICATION REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2001**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 and 50 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act I have made the following Regulations–

#### **Citation.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Medical Certification Regulations (Amendment) Regulations 2001.

#### **Amendment of the Medical Certification Regulations.**

2.(1) The Medical Certification Regulations shall be amended as follows–

- (a) regulation 2 shall be amended by deleting the definition of “insurance stamp”;
- (b) regulation 6 shall be amended as follows–
  - (i) sub-regulation (1) shall be amended by inserting after the words “Financial and Development Secretary” the words “in consultation with the Minister”;
  - (ii) for (2) there shall be substituted the following sub-regulation–

“(2) The amount in respect of any year or lesser period shall be such amount as the Financial and Development Secretary in consultation with the Minister deems reasonable taking all relevant circumstances into account.”

(2) References in the Medical Certification Regulations to the “Medical and Health Department” in all instances where such references occur, shall be substituted by references to the “Gibraltar Health Authority”.
