SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE) APPORTIONMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS (NO. 2) NOTICE, 1988.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 29(1D) of the Social Security (Insurance) Act, I hereby issue the following notice:

Title and commencement.

- 1.(1) This notice may be cited as the Social Security (Insurance) Apportionment of Contributions Notice, 1988.
- (2) This notice shall come into operation on the 2nd day of January, 1989.

Apportionment.

2. The contributions payable under the Social Security (Insurance) Act shall be payable to the Pension Fund and to the Shortterm Benefits Fund in the proportions specified in the Schedule hereto.
