Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Leisure Areas (Licensing) (No.2) Regulations, 2001.

Grant and conditions of licences.

2. Licences under the principal Act shall be issued in the appropriate form set out in Schedule 2 for a period not exceeding twelve months on such terms and conditions and subject to such restrictions as the licensing authority thinks fit.

Renewals.

3. Licences issued under these Regulations may be renewed at the discretion of the licensing authority for a further period or further periods not exceeding twelve months each.

Fees.

4. The fees payable on the grant or renewal of a licence under these Regulations are those set out in Schedule 1.

MISCELLANEOUS FORMS

1. Application for licence.

(1) All applications for any kind of licence issued under the principal Act shall be submitted to the licensing authority in the following form—

2. Application for renewal of licence.

(1) All applications for the renewal of any kind of licence issued under the principal Act shall be submitted to the licensing authority in the following form—

“To the Licensing Authority pursuant to the Leisure Areas (Licensing) Act 2001;

I/We hereby apply for the renewal to me/us of licence no.. . . for a period of days/weeks/months ending with the day of
20 .

I/We confirm that the details set out in my/our application dated [insert date] remain true, and that I/we shall inform you of any material change at the first reasonable opportunity.
