AN ACT to amend the Trade Marks Act to afford registration for service marks.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade Marks (Amendment) Act, 1987.

Amendment to Section 2.

Trade Marks (Amendment) Act, 1987.

2. The Trade Marks Act is amended in section 2 by inserting in their proper alphabetical order the following new definitions-

""goods" includes "services";"

""service mark" means a mark (including a device, name, signature, word, letter, numeral or any combination thereof) used or proposed to be used in relation to services for the purpose of indicating, or so as to indicate, that a particular person is connected, in the course of business, with the provision of those services, whether with or without any indication of the identity of that person;"

""trade mark" includes service mark".

Modifications to Trade Marks Act, 1938.

3. In its application in relation to service marks, the Trade Marks Act, 1935 shall have effect as modified by the Trade Marks (Amendment) Act, 1984 and the Patents, Designs and Marks Act, 1986.
