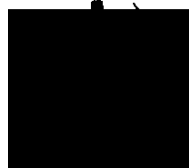

AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No.2) Act, 1988.

Amendment of section 71.

2. Section 71 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by inserting at the end thereof the following proviso-

"Provided that the foregoing provision of this subsection shall not apply where a licence has been issued or renewed upon a condition that it may not be transferred."

Amendment of section 92.

3. Section 92(1) of the Traffic Act (hereinafter called the "principal Act") is amended-

(a) in paragraph (h) thereof by deleting the words "to the Commissioner of Police";

(b) in paragraph (n) by deleting the words "to the Commissioner of Police or to any other specified public officer".

Amendment of section 99.

4. Section 99 of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (9) thereof and substituting therefor the following new subsection-

"(9) The fixed penalty for an offence shall be £5-

Provided that the Governor may by order provide for the penalty to be in any case more or less than £5."

Amendment to Section 96A..

5. Section 96A(1) is amended by repealing the word 'registered' in the first place where it appears.
