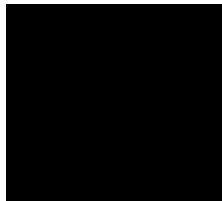

**AN ACT** to amend the Traffic Act.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title and Commencement.**

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Act 1989 and is deemed to have come into operation on 2 February, 1989.

**Amendment of Section 92.**

2. Section 92 of the Traffic Act is amended by repealing paragraphs (j) and (k) of sub-section (1) and substituting therefor the following paragraphs –

"(j) authorising the Commissioner of Police or other public officer-

(i) to sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of any vehicle (other than an abandoned vehicle) that has been detained for not less than one month in pursuance of any provisions of this Act and in respect of which the charges payable for its removal or detention have not been paid;

(ii) to sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of any vehicle abandoned on any public land;

(k) providing for the application of the proceeds of the sale of any vehicle referred to in paragraph (j) and for the reimbursement to the Crown of the costs of the removal, detention, sale or other disposal of the vehicle in so far as they are not satisfied out of the proceeds of the sale;"
