AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Act 2005.

Amendment to the Traffic Act.

2. Section 94 of the Traffic Act is replaced by the following–

“Traffic movement.

- 94(1) The Minister with responsibility for Roads and Traffic may by regulations provide for car parks, bus stops, taxi ranks, loading and waiting bays, and other general rules in respect of traffic movement, including regulating, restricting or prohibiting the parking or waiting of vehicles generally or classes of vehicles.
 - (2) The Commissioner of Police may by Order provide for temporary diversion of traffic, temporary suspension of parking spaces and loading bays and any other temporary measure required by reason of road or other works, official functions or events, the continuation of the proper movement of traffic or any emergency.
 - (3) A person who contravenes any regulations or Order made under subsection (1) or (2) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine up to level 1 on the standard scale.
