TRAFFIC ACT.

PARKING CHARGE (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 1991.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Government by section 95 of the Traffic Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Government has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Parking Charge (Amendment) Notice 1991.

Amendment to paragraph 3.

2. Paragraph 3 of the Parking Charge Notice (hereinafter called "the principal Notice") is amended

- (a) in sub-paragraph (1) by omitting the figure "(1)";
- (b) by omitting sub-paragraph (2);

Amendment to paragraph 4.

3. Paragraph 4 of the principal Notice is amended by inserting after the word "collected" the words "in a car park specified in Part 1 of the Schedule".

New paragraphs 5 and 6.

4. The principal Notice is amended by inserting after paragraph 4 new paragraphs 5 and 6 in the following terms

"Meters.

5. (1) Where in a car park listed in Part 2 of the Schedule there is a meter in operation in respect of the bay in which a motor vehicle is parked

- (a) a person in charge of a motor vehicle so parked shall cause the prescribed fee to be inserted in such meter;
- (b) it shall be an offence to insert in such meter coins additional to those inserted by way of payment of the prescribed fee;
- (c) the indications given by such meter shall be conclusive evidence of compliance or otherwise with the requirements for the payment of fees specified in the Schedule.

(2) A person who, with intent to defraud, interferes with the parking meter, or operates or attempts to operate a parking meter by the insertion of cibjects other than current coins in the appropriate denomination, shall be guilty of an offence.

Offences.

6. It shall be an offence for a person in charge of a motor vehicle

- (a) which is or has been parked in a car park specified in Part 1 of the Schedule
 - (i) and fails to produce, on being requested to do so by an authorised person, a parking ticket showing the period during which the motor vehicle was so parked;
 - (ii) and to which paragraph 4 applies to fail to comply with the requirements of paragraph 4;
- (b) to fail to remove that motor vehicle from a car park specified in Part 2 of the Schedule upon the expiry of the period in respect of which the prescribed fee has been inserted in the meter in accordance with paragraph 5."

Repeal and replacement of Schedule.

5. The Schedule to the principal Notice is repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule

Corral Road on the east side	9.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m.	the charges specified on the notice in the vicinity of the meter."
