TRAFFIC ACT.

TRAFFIC (IMMOBILISATION OF VEHICLES) (NO; Z)

(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1988.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92 of the Traffic Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations.

Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Immobilisation of Vehicles) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations, 1988.

Amendment of regulation 6.

2. The Traffic (Immobilisation of Vehicles) (No. 2) Regulations 1986 (hereinafter called the "principal regulations") are amended by revoking regulation 6 thereof and substituting therefor the following new regulation:

Notice

6. When an immobilisation device is affixed to any of device. vehicle in accordance with regulation 4, the person fixing such device shall also affix to the vehicle a notice in the form set out in the Schedule."

Replacement of regulation 7.

3. The principal regulations are further amended by revoking regulation 7 thereof and substituting therefor the following new regulation:

"Release

7. (1) A vehicle to which an immobilisation device

of vehicle. has been affixed in accordance with regulation 4

may lawfully be released from such device only by either a police officer, or a person acting under the direction of a police officer.

(2) Subject to sub-regulation (1), a vehicle to which an immobilisation device has been fixed under regulation 4 shall be released from that device only on payment by the owner or person having charge of such vehicle of the sum of £25 at the address specified in the notice affixed to the vehicle in accordance with regulation 6.

(3) Such payment shall entitle the owner or person having charge of the vehicle at the time of the application of regulation 5 to such vehicle to the release thereof as soon as the necessary arrangements for such release can be reasonably and practically made."
