Designation of Red Zone

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by regulation 26 of the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011, I hereby designate as Red Zones—

- 1. Trafalgar Interchange by-
 - (a) the east side of new main roundabout along the front of Trafalgar Tavern.
 - (b) Rosia Road along the front of the Piccadilly Gardens Restaurant and on the opposite side of the road.
 - (c) the western side of the main roundabout from the junction with Ragged Staff Road along the east side of South Bastion to Referendum Gates Archway.
- 2. Main Street from Inces Hall to the junction of Convent Ramp on both sides of the road.
- 3. Line Wall Road along-
 - (a) the east side of the road—
 - (i) from 9 Line Wall Road to the Junction at Cloister Ramp;
 - (ii) from 51 Line Wall Road to 47 Line Wall Road;
 - (iii) by Irish Place; and
 - (b) the west side of the road-
 - (i) area opposite Irish Place divided by refuse bins;
 - (ii) the entrance of Zoca Flank to the pavement;
 - (iii) Lane to the north east entrance of King's Bastion; and
 - (iv) from the north east entrance of King's Bastion heading south to the pavement.
- 4. Line Wall Road from the Junction of Kings Street along the front of the bus stop up to the Synagogue by Bomb House Lane.
- 5. Fish Market Road on both sides of the road by Ocean Heights building and the mini roundabout.
