**2014/010 Traffic (Exemptions for Specialist Use Vehicles) Order
2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 58 of the Traffic Act 2005, the Government has made the following Order—

Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic (Exemptions for Specialist Use Vehicles) Order 2014.

Exemption from provisions under Part III of Traffic Act 2005.

2.(1) In any case where—

- (a) an application is made for a motor vehicle licence in respect of a specialist use and a certificate of registration falls to be issued in respect of the vehicle accordingly,
- (b) the application is made by a licensed dealer, and
- (c) the conditions in paragraph (3) are satisfied,

the vehicle shall be exempt from any relevant provision in so far as it would require (or enable any person to require) the production of, or of any particulars derived from, a certificate of conformity.

(2) In this Article—

“specialist use vehicle” means a vehicle which is to be used outside Gibraltar and Member States for the needs of a film, media or television company in transporting and protecting their personnel and in respect of which no certificate of conformity has been issued; and

“relevant provision” means a provision of Part III of the Traffic Act 2005 or of any regulations made under that Part.

(3) The conditions referred to in paragraph (1)(c) are—

- (a) that the vehicle when in Gibraltar will always be under the control and supervision of the licensed dealer on behalf of its registered owner;
- (b) the vehicle will not be driven on roads in Gibraltar or a member State, but transported on a trailer, except for when being taken from storage to workshop and back within Gibraltar for maintenance and repairs under dealer supervision using dealer plates; and
- (c) that the vehicle will not be sold or hired (or offered for sale or hire) for use in Gibraltar or any other member State.

(4) In any case where, by virtue of the exemption provided for by this Order, a motor vehicle licence is issued in respect of a specialist use vehicle the licence shall be marked and the register noted in such manner as the licensing authority may determine to indicate that the licence is issued and the vehicle registered only by virtue of that exemption.
