AN ACT to amend the Transport Act 1998 to make provision for the inclusion of a third registered owner to road service licences in respect of taxis.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Transport (Amendment) Act 2026.

Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment of the Transport Act 1998.

- 3.(1) The Transport Act 1998 (in this Act referred to as the “principal Act”) is amended in accordance with this section.

- (2) Insert the following after section 17(1) of the principal Act-

“(1A) A road service licence in respect of a taxi shall not be issued or remain valid if more than three individuals or entities (or a combination of each) are registered as owners of the licence.”.

- (3) Insert the following after section 17(7) of the principal Act-

“(7A) Further to the provisions of subsection (7), in the case where a road service licence in respect of a taxi has three registered owners, the written consent and signature of at least two of the three registered owners shall be sufficient, unless otherwise specified by the Commission.”.

- (4) Insert the following after section 23(1) of the principal Act-

“(1A) Any transfer of ownership of a road service licence in respect of a taxi shall require the written consent and signature of all registered owners.”.
