Joint patrols and other joint operations in Gibraltar may take place only with the prior, express authorisation of the competent authority. All such operations shall remain under the exclusive command, direction and operational control of the competent authority and shall be governed exclusively by Gibraltar law. Officers seconded by another Member State shall not exercise any independent police, investigative, coercive or enforcement powers. They shall not be uniformed or carry firearms or other defensive or offensive equipment unless expressly authorised in writing by the competent authority for a specific operation. Any authorised use of force shall be governed exclusively by Gibraltar law and remain under the direction of the competent authority. Seconded officers shall comply with Gibraltar law, remain subject to its criminal jurisdiction without immunity, and the seconding Member State shall remain responsible and liable for the conduct of its officers and cooperate fully in any investigation or proceedings arising from their participation.

The requested person can revoke their consent before the magistrates' court. The magistrates' court must- (a) record in writing that the person concerned has revoked their consent to their being surrendered to the issuing State concerned or their renunciation of his entitlement to the 'speciality rule'; (b) and make such order as it deems necessary for the surrender of the person to the issuing State including an order to remand the person in custody pending the carrying out of the terms of the order.

The United Kingdom, in respect of Gibraltar, requires: (a) all requests to be in the English language; (b) the translation of any supporting documents in the English language.
